Effective September 15, 2013, Georgia state law requires that the notice must be...

- Posted in English, Spanish, and any other language deemed appropriate
- Posted in each public restroom of business or establishment
- Posted in a place near the public entrance or in clear view of the public and employees

Required Venues:

- Adult entertainment establishments
- Bars
- Bus stations
- Businesses and establishments that offer massage or bodywork services by a person who is not a massage therapist
- Emergency rooms within general acute care hospitals
- Farm labor contractors and day haulers
- Hotels
- Passenger rail or light rail stations
- Primary airports
- Privately operated job recruitment centers
- Safety rest areas located along interstate highways in this state
- Truck stops
- Urgent care centers

Effective July 1, 2017, Georgia law requires that...

The notice must ALSO be posted in all government² buildings with public access; and a link to the notice posted on the home page of every government² entity's website.
